2020 General Fund Budget, E911 Budget and Recreation Fund Budget & Position Control ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE RAISING OF REVENUES AND THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR PIERCE COUNTY, GEORGIA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2020 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020 TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPERATIONS OF GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS, BOARDS, AGENCIES, ELECTED OFFICES, AND OTHER GOVERNMENTAL ACTIVITIES; TO PROVIDE FOR THE LEVEL OF PERSONNEL AUTHORIZED FOR THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES; TO PROVIDE FOR CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE EFFECTIVE DATES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Pierce County, Georgia did meet on December 16, 2019 to discuss and consider the general operating, E911 and recreation fund budgets for the fiscal year 2020. And,

WHEREAS, Georgia Code Section 36-81-3(d) (2) allows for the Board of Commissioners to appoint a county official to authorize budget transfers below the legal level of control. And,

WHEREAS, the legal level of control will be set at the Summary Line Item Level for the 2020 Budget and the definition of summary line item will be the following major classifications within the budget; Personnel, Purchased/Contract Services, Capital Outlay, and Debt Service.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Commissioners of Pierce County, by virtue of the authority vested in them by law, as follows:

Section I. The sums of money as summarized in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance, shall be and are hereby adopted as the Operating Budget for the General Fund, E 911 Fund & Recreation Fund of Pierce County Fiscal Year 2020 (FY20), beginning January 1, 2020 and ending December 31, 2020.

Section II. The total appropriation of funds for all departments and agencies shall be \$ 9,482,450.00 – General Fund, \$ 366,982.00 – E911 Fund, and \$ 410,500.00 – Recreation Fund as provided for in the attached budget.

A detail statement of this budget is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and a position control count document is attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and is incorporated by reference.
