RESOLUTION OF PIERCE COUNTY, GEORGIA TO APPROVE TAX LEVY FOR THE YEAR 2020

Resolution and Order of the Board of Commissioners of Pierce County, Georgia levying taxes for the year 2020.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Pierce County Board of Commissioners as the governing authority of Pierce County is hereby requesting to levy a tax for the year 2020 at the rate of 16.00 mills upon the monetary assessed value of all taxable property in Pierce County, Georgia, for the maintenance and operating of Pierce County for the fiscal year 2020.

WHEREAS, the gross M&O millage for the unincorporated will be set at 16.00 mills less the rollbacks of 5.35 mills for a net M&O millage of 10.649 mills for a net taxes levied at \$3,751,073 and the gross M&O millage for the incorporated will be set at 16.00 mills less the rollbacks of 2.58 mills for a net M&O millage of 13.422 mills for a net taxes levied at \$1,688,556 for a total county taxes levied at \$5,439,629 and a total county value for 2020 at \$478,051,592.
