CALL TO ORDER – Chairman Bennett called the hearing to order at 5:45 PM.

PRAYER / PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE – Commissioner David Lowman gave an invocation and Commissioner Mike Streat led the pledge of allegiance.

2019 MILLAGE RATE – 2019 Gross Millage Rate to be set at 16.00 mills with a Rollback of 5.164 in the unincorporated area and of 2.579 in the incorporated area for a Net M & O in the unincorporated area of 10.8360 and in the incorporated area of 13.4210. This is an increase over the previous year in the unincorporated area of .495 mills and in the incorporated area of .57 mills.

Chairman Bennett opened the floor for comments. After a little discussion Angela Strickland asked how much the increase will cost the average citizen? County Manager Rubenbauer stated that the unincorporated household valued at \$100,000 would see an increase of \$25.96 and the incorporated household at the same value would see an increase of \$30.16.
