The specifications following represent the minimum characteristics desired in the culvert pipe to be purchased. These requirements are not intended to prevent obtaining fair prices or to eliminate competition, but to insure, if possible, that all bids submitted should not be subject to correction or alteration after the bid has been filed, opened, and publicly read. The Pierce County Board of Commissioners reserves the right to evaluate any or all bids, particularly where there is a range in specifications.

It is expressly understood by the bidder that written notice of the award or purchase order by the Pierce County Board of Commissioners will constitute an agreement and consummate the transaction and will serve together with the proposal, the advertisement, these instructions and the detailed specifications, as the entire form of contract between the parties.
