- E. The contractor must provide proof of General Liability Insurance, Worker's Compensation, Property Damage Insurance, E-Verify, and a business licensing.

- 6. Responsible for approval for any road closure needed during demolition.
- 7. Responsible bid price shall include all demolition, disposal, and hauling from site.
